YOUR PROGRAM INCLUDES

- **Accommodation** Shared residence-style apartments in central Berlin with WIFI included.
- **Meals** A fully equipped kitchen in each student apartment to prepare meals, and a group welcome dinner.
- **Orientation** Meeting with AIFS staff on arrival covering safety/security, local amenities, and a walking tour of Berlin.
- **Transportation** Travel pass in Berlin for use on buses, trams, S-Bahn and U-Bahn trains in central zones A & B.
- **Academics** German Life and Culture course taught by local guest lecturers, with a focus on historical, political, economic, and cultural aspects of Berlin and Germany. Additional courses to be offered by WCCCSA faculty.
- **Tours** Guided sightseeing tour of Berlin, and a guided tour of the Reichstag.
- **Cultural Activities** Calendar of free and discounted cultural activities while in Berlin such as a boat cruise, opera tickets, sporting events, museum visits, a street art workshop, and additional walking tours.
- **Excursions** Day trip to Potsdam to tour Cecilienhof Palace and Sanssouci Palace, and a half-day visit to the Memorial and Museum Sachsenhausen.
- **AIFS Study Center & Student Services** AIFS support staff available for information, personal advising/ counseling, and 24-hour emergency contact service.
- **Comprehensive Medical Insurance**

OPTIONAL BALTIC WEEKEND

An optional 3-day/2-night excursion to the Baltic Sea by train, with accommodation in shared rooms within a centrally located hostel in Warnemuende, daily breakfast and dinner, and sightseeing and walking tours, museum entry, and the services of an AIFS representative throughout for \$464.

A 10-student minimum is required for this trip to run.

PROGRAM FEE

Based on an enrollment of 15-21 participants, the fee per person is \$7,045.

This fee excludes the optional medical insurance upgrade (\$65), airfare and in-country transfers, passport and/or visa fees if applicable, meals other than those listed, personal expenses, any WCCCSA tuition and/or administrative fees, textbooks, additional field trips and/or excursions required by WCCCSA and anything else not specified.

*Students who withdraw after this date but on or before the final payment deadline may receive a refund for all fees paid less the \$450 deposit and any non-refundable deposits paid by the student or by AIFS on the student's behalf.

** There are no refunds for students who withdraw after this date. Enrolled students who have not paid in full by this date are contractually responsible for the full program fee.
